## Visualizing Lean Manufacturing

“Joint Meeting With NAPM Columbus”

Lean manufacturing is a methodology for eliminating waste and was first developed by the Toyota Motor Company.

The methodology is widely used in the United States today and has, at its heart, the concepts of Just In Time, Waste Reduction and Quality Improvement.

The methodology is initiated by developing “Current State” value stream maps that show the flow of information and materials associated with a product.

These maps lead to planned “Future State” maps that improve the flow, resulting in benefits such as inventory reduction, capacity increase, and lead time reduction. Many of these maps are created by hand today and can be shared and modified only with difficulty.

The presentation “Visualizing Lean Manufacturing” demonstrates an electronic means of creating Value Stream maps following the visual language outlined in the best selling book “Learning to See” from the Lean Enterprise Institute (LEI). This electronic approach was developed by GumshoeKI in collaboration with a leading local practitioner of lean manufacturing, Techsolve. The discussion should be of interest to anyone in the manufacturing industry who is interested in further understanding a mainstream technique for gaining competitive advantage.
