Join us for a presentation by Dr. Peter Ward – Why isn't Every Plant Lean?

Peter Ward is Professor of Operations Management and Chair of the Department of Management Sciences at Ohio State University's Max M. Fisher College of Business, located in Columbus, Ohio, USA. Peter teaches popular electives in operations strategy, lean manufacturing, and six-sigma in the Fisher College MBA program. Peter also participates frequently in executive education programs including developing successful one and four-week certificate programs in lean management.

Peter is Associate Director for Research in the Center for Operational Excellence at Ohio State. He serves as a member of the advisory board of Ford Motor Company's Lean Resource Center and serves as a judge for *Industry Week's* America's Best Plants Program. He is also the Otto Mønsted Guest Professor at the Technical University of Denmark where he does research in the Center for Technology, Engineering, and Management. Peter has served as a consultant to a number of corporations.

Dr. Ward's research has resulted in numerous articles which have appeared in leading operations management journals and he has been recognized with a number of awards including the Shingo Prize for research in 2004 and Fisher College's Pacesetters Research award in 2003. He is associate editor for *Journal of Operations Management* and *Decision Sciences Journal*. His research focuses gaining competitive advantage through operations.

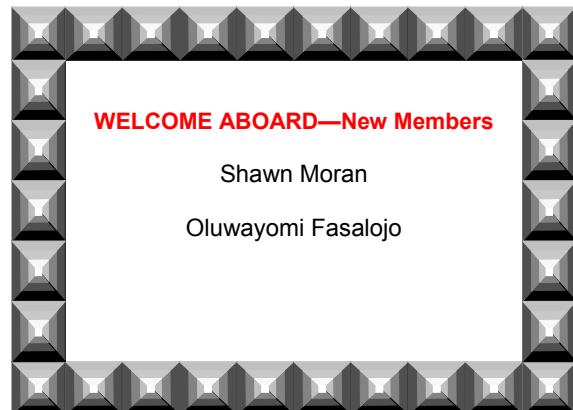
