Please park in the parking lot adjacent to the pond. Proceed to the Visitor’s Center located in the park.

**Tour Write Up:**

Join us as we tour Velvet Ice Cream. Long a familiar tourist attraction in Central Ohio, Ye Olde Mill has been readapted into an historical museum, ice cream parlor and restaurant by the Velvet Ice Cream Company. The original grist mill was built in 1817 in one of Ohio’s most scenic locations, the Licking Valley. In years past, the mill provided a local meeting place to fish, picnic and exchange news and gossip. Today, you’ll find that same warm and friendly atmosphere awaiting you in what is know as Ohio’s Ice Cream Capital.

Ye Olde Mill houses Ohio’s only Ice Cream Museum – telling the story of ice cream from Roman times to the present. Antique ice cream-making equipment is displayed along with lots of fun facts and history about America’s favorite frozen dessert. You will also have the opportunity to watch ice cream being made on the production line.

Ye Olde Mill:

The Mill features an authentic 18-foot, 8,000 lb. Waterwheel that was used to power the stones that ground the wheat into flour. It also is the home to Ohio’s only Ice Cream Museum and the Museum of Milling. In the museum you can step back in time to see and read about how ice cream developed from earlier times through the present.
