Greetings from Buckeye Operations Management Society! BOMS has had an eventful summer, and is in the process of planning a number of excellent events for fall quarter.

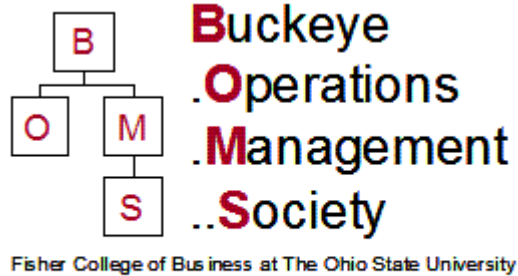
